RESOLUTION 7-2026

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF SKAMANIA COUNTY
PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF CHECKS BEFORE APPROVAL BY THE COMMISSIONERS**

WHEREAS, this Resolution supersedes and repeals all previous resolutions to include 2-2025 regarding the Issuance of Warrants; and

WHEREAS, prior approval of the Port of Skamania County Board of Commissioners for the expenditure of funds for certain operating expenses and other purposes (claims) is frequently made necessary by Federal and State statutes, contractual agreements, and other requirements; and

WHEREAS, the prepayment of such claims is specifically authorized by RCW 42.24.180 subject to certain conditions; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Skamania County that prepayment of claims in the amount of \$1,00,311.41 is approved retroactively for the calendar year 2025, subject to the following conditions:

1. The Executive Director and the Officer(s) designated to sign the warrants must have an official bond;
2. Contracting, hiring, purchasing, and disbursing policies that implement effective internal controls shall be maintained;
3. Documentation supporting claims paid and all checks issued in payment of claims shall be made available for review by the Port of Skamania County Board of Commissioners at its next regularly scheduled public meeting; and
4. If, upon review, the Port of Skamania County Board of Commissioners disapproves a paid claim, the Executive Director and/or other persons who signed the check shall jointly cause the disapproved claim to be recognized as a receivable of the Port and to pursue collection diligently until the amount disapproved is collected or until the Commission is satisfied and approves the claim.

PASSED IN SESSION THIS 21st day of January 2026, retroactive to calendar year 2025. The Board has reviewed and ratifies all payments shown on Attachment "A".
